From Donnie Brown: President

- Welcome
- Band Camp Complete – Great Job on the Premier showcasing how far they have come in a short amount of time. We are excited about the upcoming season!!
- Schedule Highlights
 - Boston butt fundraiser forms are going out. Pick up will be 8/27.
 - Away game at TL Hanna 8/19 – signups for the kids are posted outside the band room. Anyone with a truck capable of pulling a trailer, please see Donnie to volunteer for helping get the band equipment to the away games.
 - Color guard has the last car wash of the year at Advance Auto 8/20
 - Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday 4-7 is the regular after school practice schedule
 - No pep band on 9/23 to Clover. It is too far.
 - 1st competition is at Byrnes on 9/24
 - Festival of Bands is 10/8. We will need many volunteers. It is our biggest fundraiser. We have 37 bands scheduled!
 - 10/31 Trunk or Treat – costumes will be up to the directors.
 - Friends and Family show is tentatively scheduled for the Friday before state. We are waiting on school approval right now.
- Looking for a transportation solution to get the middle school kids to practice. School does not have drivers yet for activity buses.
- Reminder – practice pick up is at the front of the main high school. Please do NOT park on the side of the street.
- Outstanding band fees need to be paid to BSHS. You can pay via MySchoolFees. Band shoe payments can be given to the directors.
- Students love to hear you cheer for them at the competitions. Be there and BE LOUD! Be involved. Cheer, scream, and applaud. We will need help with props.
- Students will be bused to all competitions. Pit crew leaves a little before the band to set up.
- Concessions update: Hoping to finish renovations by 8/19. We will not be manning the athletic side this year. We will have our concession stand and a trailer at the away side.
- After concession renovation is complete, they will start on our storage building by the tennis courts. There were a few hiccups with the design but there will be plenty of room to store equipment and props.
- Uniforms will ship 8/25



- Game ticket is included if you volunteer in concessions. We want no Senior parents to work concessions during Senior night unless you want to.

From Michele Thornton: 1st Vice President

- Volunteers needed in all areas: buses, guides, tunnels, concessions, etc. Signups will be posted soon. They will be set up into three shifts/time slots. You can work ½ day or all day. You will not miss your kid's performance. Kids will work the earlier shifts so we will need the adults to volunteer mostly for afternoon/evening shifts. Looking into shirts to sell that day.

From Tyler Scarabino: Director of Bands

- Thank you for everything done at band camp. Great start.
- Hope to have uniforms in house by the end of August. 182 units, 4 drum major units, and the wraps for the shakos. It is a more modern uniform. No arms. We can change the color dynamics with just a change of the undershirt. Future shows won't be limited by color scheme or graphic budgets. Ordered 96 new bibbers with the plan to get the rest next year and have them embroidered with the Bulldog logo. The original quote went from \$30,000 to \$42,000 which is why there won't be all new bibbers this year. Students will receive a performance shirt to wear beneath their uniform and a show shirt. Parent shirt is coming soon.
- We are trying to get pink plumes for October's Breast Cancer Awareness Month.
- The suppliers are having trouble with the backpacks. Originally said they would be here in November but have promised to have them here by 9/20 in time for Byrnes
- Students will be responsible for their uniform
- Looking into Calendar fundraiser – checking w/front office.
- Band will perform after the game on the 1st and 3rd game and during halftime on the 2nd and 4th game
- Scheduled to clean the stadium after one game this season.
