- Few upcoming: mini camp begins Monday, instrument-selecting the right people for the marching band: we had a strong senior class but also have a strong junior class moving in. Final Audition on May 12th.
- Begin Monday 4-7pm
- Spoke about graduation and parking: the way we did parking in the past will not be the way we do it this year. Must have fire lane access open at all times.
- It is part of the class grade to be in the graduation band. (9-11 grade)
- It is important for students to leave their Bulldog Legacy and it is the biggest event where we have the most eyes on the kids performing.
- May 19th parent meeting (nuts and bolts for 2025 7-8pm) (rookie parent meet 8-9pm all things new and upcoming)
- Chamber concert this Friday
- May 6th shout out to all Fine Arts Concert. Support all programs. Who are we inviting to the event.
- Graduation (school will still be in secession and kids will get shuttled from First Baptist)
- Scarabino spoke about Booster operations: He has been majorly reflecting on things and refocusing efforts: 1st- issue with titles, jobs, etc: He will disband all





committees (too many issues)- no parents will have titles/jobs and Mr Scarabino will be all point of contact!

- He does not want any parent to feel he cannot have a relationship with them or their child.
