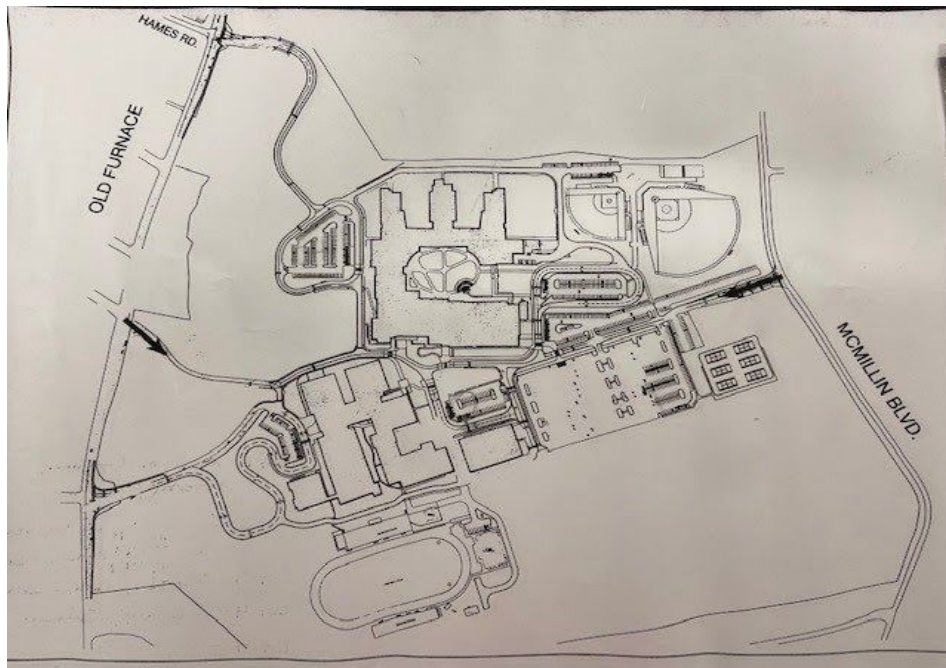


# Student Entry and Exit Plan

In order to get students safely on and off campus there are a few rules that we all need to follow. Please make sure that you read through this in its entirety so that we are all on the same page and are able to allow for a quick, safe campus.

Below is a map of the camps. There are two entrances on Old Furnace Rd. The main entrance of the school comes off of Hames Rd while the bus entrance is in between the new high school campus and the new 9th grade campus. The bus entrance is marked with a black arrow on the map below. The entrance off of McMillan Blvd. is called the student entrance. It is also marked with an arrow on the map below.



**Student Entry for self drivers:** Enter via the student entrance on McMillan Blvd and park in the student lots. You will walk to the side entrance of the school (the covered entrance between the high school and 9th grade). There will be a screening table for you to check in with before entering the school. Please make sure you practice social distancing of at least 6 ft while around the table and entry way.

**Student Entry for Drop Off:** Enter via the student entrance on McMillan Blvd and drive to the covered walkway between the new high school and 9th grade campus. You will see a table set up for screening. We ask that parents do not leave until screening is complete.

**Student Pick-up:** Students will wait for parents along the sidewalk in front of the school. Please use the main entrance (at the intersection of Hames Rd. and Old Furnace) and drive around to pick up your students. We ask that you be as punctual as possible when picking up students.

With other groups coming in and out it will not be possible for staff to watch students waiting for pickup for longer than 15 minutes.

#### 4 ABSOLUTE RULES:

1. If a student does not clear screening, they will be sent home.
2. If a student does not have a water source, they will be sent home.
3. If a student does not have a mask, they will be sent home.
4. If a student does not have a waiver filled out, they will be sent home.

I normally do not operate on absolutes like this but due to the ongoing pandemic, these are the four rules that we must follow.
